Application by Wasaga Distribution Inc. for an Exemption from their Mandated Time-of-Use Pricing Date

The Application

Wasaga Distribution Inc. ("Wasaga Distribution") filed an application dated April 2, 2011 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 74 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B) for a licence amendment granting an exemption in relation to the mandated date for the implementation of Time-of-Use ("TOU") pricing rates for Regulated Price Plan ("RPP") consumers.

Time-of-Use Pricing

On August 4, 2010 the Ontario Energy Board issued a determination under Section 1.2.1 of the Standard Supply Service Code to require the implementation of TOU pricing for RPP consumers. The determination established mandatory TOU implementation dates for each electricity distributor. Wasaga Distribution has applied for an exemption from its June 2011 mandatory TOU date and has requested a new date of November 2011. The exemption is as a result of delays experienced implementing a new customer information system and advanced metering infrastructure and technical issues that have arisen during testing with the Independent Electricity System Operator.
